



Congressman Charles Wilson Contracting Opportunities Award for Prime Contractors



Purpose of the Award:

Congressman Charles Wilson Contracting Opportunities Award for Prime Contractors is to recognize the prime contractors that developed the small businesses of the Deep East Texas area through the awarding of subcontracts. This includes the counties of the Deep East Texas Council of Governments (Angelina, Houston, Jasper, Nacogdoches, Newton, Polk, Sabine, San Augustine, San Jacinto, Shelby, Trinity, and Tyler) and The Alabama-Coushatta Tribe of Texas. These counties formed the heart of the former 2nd Congressional District of Texas that Congressman Wilson represented for 24 years, from 1973 till 1997.

Procedure:

The period to be covered for the awards will be from 1 January 2010 through 31 December 2010, based on the actual date the award was made. An award can include credit card purchases, purchase orders, and contracts. The information must be provided to ACPAC NLT 1 April 2011 to allow award verification.
